A brief insight into the PMA Community activities - autumn/winter semester

- <u>Mastering the Erasmus+ Application Form for Cooperation Partnerships</u> (February 20th 10.30 12.00)
- Open topic of your choice (date will be announced when we know the exact deadline for Cooperation Partnership submission)

You may register for the sessions that are of interest to you <u>here</u> and as always, you are more than welcome to extend the invitation to colleagues at your institution who might also wish to join and participate.

Co-creation of the sessions: The topics for this academic year have been carefully aligned with the priorities you highlighted in the feedback survey circulated in June - thank you for your invaluable input.
